Island, and with members of the Mission Discovery team. It was a special blessing to share in ministry with brother Sam Vassell in New York and to renew fellowship with those at "homebase" in New Jersey.

There was a rekindling of missionary zeal and fervour and a demonstration that, despite September 11, there are many determined to demonstrate the love of Christ Jesus our Lord who came to seek and save the lost. In addition to mission teams already confirmed, we are expecting others as well as holiday groups to share with us at the Centre in the months ahead.

Team Work School

There are still many of our high school students in need of sponsorship help for tuition of \$900 annually.

Sponsorship for students in the Preparatory Department is \$720 per year.
